

ARTISTIC CHALLENGE

On June 4, 2007, Noah Scalin made an orange paper skull and posted it online, announcing that he was going to make a skull a day for a year. He made his 365th skull on June 2, 2008 (and even posted a bonus skull the day after, since it was a leap year.)

This is not a new idea. Artists through the ages have given themselves challenges to break out of a rut, ramp up their creativity and recharge their artistic drive. Now it is your turn! :-) WOO-HOOOOO!

THE RULES:

- 1) Choose an object (no skulls- be original!) to recreate **twelve** times in twelve days.
- 2) Use at least 6 different media-be creative and unique!
- 3) At least two of the creations must be three-dimensional.
- 4) At least one of the creations must involve other people.
- 5) If the creation is temporary, take a photo of it and turn it in as proof of the piece.
- 6) Choose the sizes that works best for each individual piece.
